

# Spicy Soy-Glazed Salmon

#### It's a three-fer... Healthy, Tasty and Time Saving!

#### Ingredients:

5 Stalks Celery, thinly sliced

1 Bunch Green Onions, thinly sliced

4 oz Green Chiles

1 Tbsp Oil

1/8 Tsp Salt

4 (6 oz) Skinless Salmon Fillets

2 Tbsp Low Sodium Soy Sauce

1/4 Cup Unsalted Peanuts



#### Directions:

- 1. Preheat oven 450 Degrees
- 2. On large rimmed baking sheet, toss celery, green onions, chiles, oil and salt together. Roast at 450 degrees for 15 minutes; stirring twice.
- 3. In 2 quart square baking dish, drizzle salmon fillets with soy sauce. Roast for 12 minutes or until opaque.
- 4. Serve salmon with celery mixture. Garnish with unsalted peanuts and green onions.

Serve with steamed bok choy for an added treat!

## CRISPY BAKED SHRIMP SCAMPI

#### **INGREDIENTS**

2 LBS Shrimp peeled 2 T Lemon juice 2 T White Wine (optional) 1 Shallot, minced 1/3 C Melted Butter, divided Salt and Pepper 1/3 C Panko Bread crumbs 4 Cloves Garlic, minced 2tbs grated Parmesan Cheese 1/2 tsp crushed red pepper flake 1/4 Cup Fresh Parsley chopped Lemon wedge to garnish

- 1. Heat Oven to 425f. In a oven—proof baking dish, combine the shrimp, lemon, juice, white wine, shallots, 2tbs of melted butter, 1 tsp salt and 1/4 tsp pepper. Mix well until the shrimp are evenly coated. Set aside.
- 2. In a small bowl, combine the remaining melted butter, bread crumbs, garlic, parmesan cheese, red pepper flakes and 2tbs of chopped parsley. Mix Well.
- 3. Sprinkle the breadcrumb mixture over the shrimp and bake for 12 minutes, or until hot and bubbling and the shrimp are 'just' cooked through. Change oven setting to broil or grill for a further minute or so, until the top is crispy and golden.
- 4. Garnish with remaining parsley, squeeze over a drizzle of lemon juice and serve with lemon wedge.
