Salad:

2 Tomatoes, Diced

4 Cucumbers, Peeled & Diced

1/2 Cup Red Onion, Diced

1 Cup Feta Cheese Crumbles

5 Oz Kalamata Olives, Pitted

Mix dressing ingredients together in a small bowl. Set aside. Peel & dice vegetables in a salad bowl. Add feta chees & Kalamata olives. Mix together until salad dressing coats vegetables. Cover & refrigerate for 1 hour before serving for best flavor.
