

Calling all Carb-Lovers! World Pasta Day is celebrated on October 25th this year. Here's some lip-smacking tidbits you might not know:

People have been eating pasta since at least 5,000 BC. However this delightful holiday was only established in 1995 when 40 pasta producers from around the world gathered to hold the globe's first World Pasta Congress.

Buca di Beppo Italian Restaurant in Garden Grove, California successfully created the World's Largest Bowl of Pasta according to the Guinness World Records. Using a repurposed swimming pool as a pasta bowl, measuring 15' in diameter by 3.5' high. The pool was filled with more than 13,786 pounds of pasta and 120 gallons of sauce to acquire the title.

It took over 20 people, working full-time for a week, to cook spaghetti and create a "bucket brigade" to fill the massive "bowl". Six chefs supervised the preparation and production. Once the title was official, the mounds of pasta was donated to the local agricultural community to be used as animal feed. "Mission Impastable" Complete!



Cinnamon Apple Pie Bread

Ditch the homemade pie crust. Dip into this flavorful, quick & easy recipe that's as sweet as apple pie!

Ingredients

1/3 cup light brown sugar (not packed)

1 teaspoon ground cinnamon

²/₃ cup white sugar

½ cup salted butter, softened (or use unsalted and add ¼ tsp salt)

2 eggs

1½ teaspoons vanilla extract

1½ cups all-purpose flour

1³/₄ teaspoons baking powder

½ cup milk

1 granny smith apple, peeled and chopped

Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Grease and flour a 9 x 5-inch loaf pan.
- 2. Mix brown sugar and cinnamon together in a mixing bowl and set aside.
- 3. Beat white sugar and butter together in a bowl using an electric mixer until smooth and creamy. Beat in eggs, 1 at a time, until incorporated; add vanilla extract and stir until incorporated.
- 4. Combine flour and baking powder together in another bowl; stir into creamed butter mixture. Mix milk into batter until smooth.
- 5. Pour half the batter into the prepared loaf pan. Next add half the apples and half the brown sugar cinnamon mixture. Lightly pat/push apple mixture into batter. Pour the remaining batter over apple layer; top with remaining apples and add more brown sugar/cinnamon mixture. Lightly pat/push apples into batter; swirl brown sugar mixture through apples using a finger or spoon
- 6. Bake in the preheated oven until a toothpick inserted in the center of the loaf comes out clean, 30 to 40 minutes.

Tip: If you notice it getting too brown on the top, cover it loosely with tin foil and continue baking until the inside is done.

Things you'll need:


- (1) colorful leaves

Place a thin layer of Mod Podge on the jar. Then place a leaf on the mod podge and continue until the jar is sporadically covered in leaves. Leave some "free" space on the jar to allow the candle glow to seep through.

Cover the leaves in a thin layer of Mod Podge and let dry.

Place a tealight candle inside the jar and carefully light the candle.
