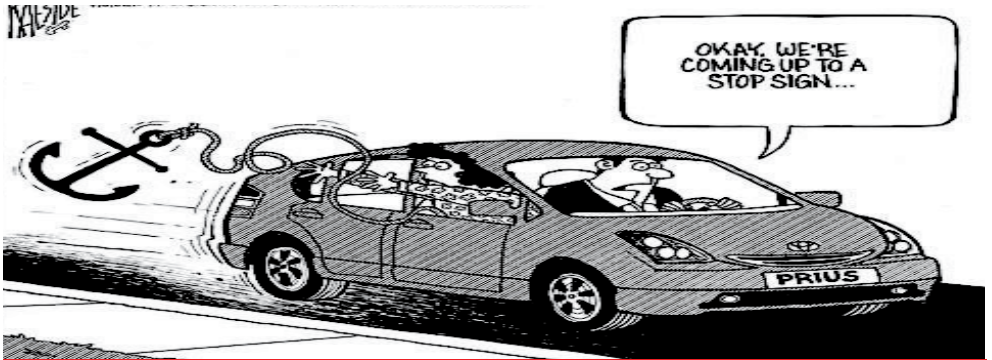

Eruption decapitates St. Helens; at least 9 die; Spirit Lake gone

Mount St. Helens exploded in volcanic fury Sunday, unleashing massive mudflows, floods and other lava-chang- ing forces that killed at least nine per- sons, eliminated Washington's Spirit Lake and sent ashfall in ash clouds east by Sunday night but moved as far as Wyoming.

The mountain's elevation dropped from 8,977 to 8,400 feet after eruptions began liberally ripping the peak apart at 8:32 a.m. Sunday.

The initial explosion was heard more than 100 miles away. The north- board at the Vancouver, British Colum- bia, police station "lit up like a Chris- mas tree" with calls reporting the explosion, a newspaper said.

The intense heat explosion severed a 15-mile-wide arc around the mountain's north flank, trapping and killing at least eight persons caught in their cars on Washington 504. The explosive force cut back at least its path and leveled cabins and resorts.

Authorities who attributed a slash south to the volcano. They said a crop- cutter was killed when his airplane crashed into power lines near Ellensburg when visibility was impaired by ash.

Hundreds of persons were evacu- ated from around the mountain, but au- thorities said many persons were un- accounted for. The Douglas County sher- iff's department expected the death toll to increase.

The eruptions triggered mudflows, flash floods and lightning storms that covered their own lanes of debris.



Residents of Toutle flee flood

FOURTEEN South — The Toutle Lake School was transformed into a heli-opter emergency port Sunday as military aircraft airlifted dozens of residents stranded by the flood-choked Toutle River.

Volcanoes caused by Mount St. Helens' volcanic eruptions sent waters 20 feet high down the Toutle River Valley. The raging river drowned trees, smashed bridges and washed out roads.

Ellis Calvert, who lives in the Tou-tle River hamlet of Cold Valley, said she knew it was time to leave when a house and several cars floated downstream Sunday morning near her home.

"I said, 'Oh, my God, it's finally hap- pening,'" she said, after leaving in a heli-opter at the school a few miles west of her home.

"You could hear the river just roar- ing," said Mrs. Calvert, who was accom- panied with her husband and four children by a U.S. Coast Guard helicopter.

Patrick Cooney, another Cold Valley resident, flew out in the same heli-opter. He brought his pet box cat, Josephine, with him. "Our place (about eight miles from the school) is still safe,

I was 16 years old and I could see Mt St. Helens from my bedroom window. I lived in Portland, Or. I was attending Parkrose Highschool as a Junior and had a front row seat to the mountains daily shows.

I remember driving our 1965 Corvaire that had been our Grandpas and sliding around on the ash like it was snow. Man that was fun. Tee DuFresne

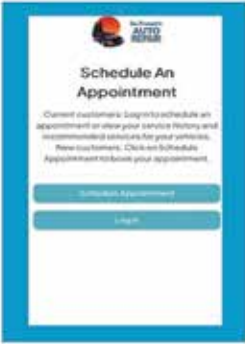
