In the most recent study conducted in 2017, it showed that 13,000 injuries and 8 deaths were caused by fireworks, and even the simplest, as the sparklers caused 1,200 injuries. The best thing to do is to be an advocate for the safe use of fireworks in your community and let the professionals handle the work, to avoid the consequences of malfunctioning and careless use. 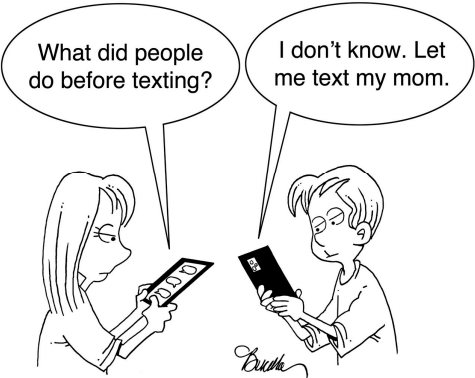

# Rose Festival Makes A Come Back!

After two summers without a Rose Festival in Portland, summer 2022 will see the return of all three of the festival's parades and more, the festival announced Thursday. "The Rose Festival is back this year for the Rose City Reunion," said Jeff Curtis, Portland Rose Festival CEO, in a press release. "The Rose Festival is happy to be part of Portland's comeback story." The festival will begin on May 27, with opening night ceremonies and fireworks and the return of the City Fair. The Starlight Parade will take to Portland's streets on June 4. Curtis noted that that parade will now be sponsored by Oregon Health Plan insurance provider CareOregon, a newly-minted "premier sponsor" of the event. The Junior Parade is scheduled for June 8 and the Grand Floral Parade is set for June 11. The festival's 2022 theme, Rose City Reunion, "is meant to capture the spirit of Oregonians coming back together to celebrate and reinvigorate our sense of community pride and togetherness," according to the release. Though most of the in-person celebrations have been dormant for two years, the Rose Festival has crowned two queens during the coronavirus pandemic. In 2021, the festival named its first queen who was the daughter of a previous queen in front of an audience of about 200 people.

## Grilled Garlic Artichokes

Ingredients:

2 Jumbo Artichokes

6 Cloves Garlic

1/2 Cup Butter

Salt, Pepper and Italian  
seasoning to taste

Preheat Grill/Oven to 375 degrees. Cut very top off then cut in half lengthwise. Remove the fuzzy stuff in the center and remove the purple inner leaves by pulling them all together, discard. Rinse the half's under cold water, turn over and drain out water. Melt butter with garlic. Place artichokes on individual foil pieces. Drizzle garlic butter in center and over the leaves. Season to taste with salt, pepper and Italian seasoning. Wrap tight with foil. Place foil packets on grill. Cook 45-60 minutes depending on size. Take out of foil packet and put face down on grill, just long enough to make the lines. Plate and squeeze fresh lemon on each half. *Dip leaves in your favorite dipping sauces. My favorite is drawn butter. Another popular dipping sauce is a mayo and herbs.*

To have a safe road trip: Prepare yourself, your passengers, your vehicle. You may have taken any number of long road trips before and think you know just how to do it right. When you make your plan, however, consider these points.

About your car: Obviously, you will want to make sure that your tires have plenty of tread and there are no operational problems that should be corrected. Make sure all fluids are at the right levels and there are no leaks. Once on the road, keep an eye on warning lights so you know if your engine is overheating.



About yourself: While you're busy with packing, calling to have your newspapers held and planning rest and fuel stops in advance, remember to think about yourself. Don't leave things to do that will take you into late the night before you leave. Get a good night's rest before you start. And remember that hunger and lack of exercise can contribute to the fatigue caused by driving for long periods of time. Before you leave, find out where you can stop, eat, exercise and nap.

About your passengers: It's a good idea to have one of your passengers be a licensed driver so you can alternate. Be sure to take any medications those in the car might need. If you are taking kids, then games, videos, and snacks will keep them entertained so they don't hassle you while you are at the wheel.

About other drivers: Know how you will react when another driver cuts you off or makes a rude gesture. There are thousands of roadway aggression incidents each year. The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration estimates that about one-third of all motor-vehicle collisions could be traced to aggressive driving.

## Give that mower a new lease on life

If your lawn mower is a few years old and not running as it did when it was new, don't give up on it yet. **The average life span of a mower in the U.S. is just three years.** If an owner takes care of a mower, however, it can last far longer. Here's how to start: Change the spark plug. Plugs can erode, but replacing one will ensure a quick start. Then get the blade sharpened. To remove it, always start by removing the spark plug. Usually the blade is held by only one bolt. Sharp blades make grass look nice and reduce engine strain. Lubricate all the moving parts with a silicone spray. Spread a little oil on the wheels where they turn at the axle and on any moving parts on the handle. If the mower has carburetor problems, take it to a repair shop. For about \$100, they will take it apart and clean it out so it will last you another season or three.
